**ORDER APPOINTING THE CITY OF PLANTATION POLICE
OFFICERS PENSION FUND AS LEAD PLAINTIFF AND
APPROVING ITS SELECTION OF LEAD COUNSEL**

Upon consideration of (1) the Motion of the City of Plantation Police Officers Pension Fund (“Plantation Police”) for appointment as Lead Plaintiff and approval of its selection of Lead Counsel; (2) the Memorandum of Law in support thereof; (3) the Declaration of Mollie Pawlosky; and (4) all other pleadings and argument submitted to this Court; and for good cause shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Plantation Police’s Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. Plantation Police is **APPOINTED** to serve as Lead Plaintiff pursuant to Section 21D(a)(3)(B) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, 15 U.S.C. § 78u-4(a)(3)(B), as amended by the Private Securities Litigation Reform Act of 1995, in the above-captioned action and all related actions consolidated pursuant to paragraph 4 of this Order.
3. Plantation Police’s selection of Counsel is **APPROVED**, and Bernstein Litowitz Berger & Grossmann LLP is **APPOINTED** as Lead Counsel for the Class.
4. Pursuant to Rule 42(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, any subsequently filed, removed, or transferred actions that are related to the claims asserted in the above-captioned action are **CONSOLIDATED** for all purposes.
5. This action shall be captioned “*In re Meredith Corporation Securities Litigation*” and the file shall be maintained under Master File No. 4:19-cv-00294-CRW-RAW.
