Caitlin Heim is an Assistant Counsel for Securities Litigation and Corporate Governance for the New York State Common Retirement Fund. In that capacity, she actively supervised prosecution of the Boeing shareholder derivative case, in which the New York State Comptroller served as Lead Plaintiff. The Boeing case resulted in the largest monetary settlement in a Caremark case in Delaware at \$237.5 million, as well as significant corporate governance reforms to enhance safety oversight at the company. In addition to securities litigation, Caitlin

also provides legal support to the Fund's Bureau of Corporate Governance, which facilitates the integration of environmental, social and governance issues (ESG) into the Fund's investment processes. Caitlin has been with the New York State Comptroller's Office since 2008 and has been working on securities litigation and corporate governance matters since 2019. Caitlin is a graduate of Albany Law School and the University of Vermont.
