ADL'S HISTORY AND MISSION

ADL was founded at a time when American Jews, both new immigrants and generations-long members of our society, were experiencing deep-seated bigotry. Culture turned a blind eye to acts that today would have been called hate crimes. Against this backdrop of bias and intolerance, Sigmund Livingston, an attorney from Chicago, put forward the bold idea to create an organization that worked "to stop the defamation of the Jewish people, and to secure justice and fair treatment to all." In 1913, ADL was formed with that critical mission in place and the clear understanding that the fight against one form of prejudice cannot succeed without battling prejudice in all its forms.

Today, 110 years later, ADL is recognized as the world's leading anti-hate organization and uses innovation and partnerships to drive impact. A global leader in countering extremism, combating antisemitism, and battling bigotry, ADL works to protect democracy and ensure a just and inclusive society for all.

ADL'S WORK AND IMPACT

ADL strives to protect all marginalized groups from the impacts of extremism; reduce bias in individuals through education; and create an environment of laws and norms where all groups are treated fairly. ADL achieves these objectives through reactive and proactive efforts:

Investigate and Research

ADL tracks extremism of all kinds and releases original research on trends in hate both offline and online—from the role of misogyny in white supremacy to the potential for artificial intelligence to identify hateful comments. Additionally, ADL's research is a critical tool for law enforcement agencies to better understand and investigate hate crimes.

Educate and Train

ADL is one of the largest providers in the U.S. of anti-bias and bullying prevention education in schools, with our trainers and curriculum reaching 5.5 million school children annually. We are also the largest trainer of law enforcement in the U.S. on hate crimes and bias, training an estimated 15,000 officers every year, including all first year FBI agents and NYPD officers.

Advocate and Assist

ADL works with elected officials and policy makers at the federal, state and local levels to ensure they protect the civil rights of all Americans. We have spearheaded victories including the creation of hate crime laws in 45 states and filed legal briefs in some of the nation's most important civil rights cases. We also work with social media platforms to advocate for changes that reduce cyberhate. Finally, we engage diverse coalitions, companies and individuals to amplify our message and join others in the fight against hate and bias.

PARTNERS AGAINST HATE

With antisemitism on the rise, it is imperative that workplaces join the fight against bias and hatred and ensure that addressing antisemitism and the experiences of Jewish employees are part of organizational culture and workplace diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI) strategies.

ADL's 2022 Audit of Antisemitic Incidents recorded 3,697 incidents of assault, harassment and vandalism against Jews in the U.S., the highest number since ADL began tracking in 1979. A recent ADL survey found that 63% of Jews had experienced or witnessed an antisemitic incident in the past five years and that business establishments were the fourth most frequent location where antisemitic incidents took place.

Unchecked antisemitism and bias in the workplace inevitably affect employees and lead to a non-inclusive work culture that normalizes hate. ADL is proud to work with corporations and law firms to provide antisemitism education programming and resources that help create workplaces that are inclusive spaces where all employees can thrive.

ADL has advised companies from a range of industries, from technology and media, to hospitality to construction, to law and real estate, on how to deal with hate on their platforms and in their workplaces. Beyond this work, ADL has organized high-profile coalition-based campaigns like Stop Hate for Profit. This campaign united ADL, the NAACP, LULAC, Color of Change and Common Sense Media, and others with more than 1,100 brands in a successful effort that exposed Facebook for its lax approach to combating antisemitism and racism.

As an ADL Corporate Partner Against Hate, an organization can access the full range of ADL workplace educational services including virtual and in-person presentations, Lunch & Learn sessions with ADL content experts, and private briefings with ADL Leadership. DEFENDING CIVIL RIGHTS

At ADL, we work towards a world characterized by justice and respect for all people, and free of all forms of discrimination. Our efforts to combat hate embrace all individuals and groups that face bias and inequity. We make an impact by raising awareness through education, advocating for change in the legislative and legal arenas, and speaking out in the press, social media and other influential forums against discriminatory practices.

ADL fights for equal treatment before the law through our civil rights work on behalf of targeted individuals and communities. We are plaintiffs in voting rights cases. We file or join amicus briefs in cases concerning religious freedom, immigrants and refugees, racial justice, LGBTQ+ rights, gender equity and other civil rights issues. We join and convene coalitions to protect civil rights, and we advocate for strong hate crimes laws and online hate laws to support those who are targeted victims and hold perpetrators responsible.

Lawyers Division

Co-chaired by Alan M. Klinger, Co-Managing Partner, Stroock & Stroock & Lavan LLP, and Gregg L. Weiner, Partner, Ropes & Gray LLP, the region's Lawyers Division advances ADL's mission through philanthropic leadership and community outreach, and provides invaluable support for ADL's legal positions and initiatives. Comprised of prominent individual practitioners and attorneys from leading firms and corporations, throughout New York and New Jersey, the Division engages with and empowers the broader legal community, hosts various insider briefings with ADL content experts, and organizes a series of CLE webinars and special events throughout the year.



Alex Edelman is a comedian, actor, and writer. He is known both for his solo shows – three, all award-winning, sell-out hits in London's West End and the Edinburgh Fringe Festival – and for his TV writing. His first solo show, Millennial, won the 2014 Edinburgh Comedy Award for Best Newcomer, the first American show to do so since 1997. Edelman has appeared on "The Late Show with Stephen Colbert," "Late Night with Seth Meyers," and "Conan," and written for shows like "The Great Indoors" (CBS) and Jenji Kohan's "Teenage Bounty Hunters" for Netflix.

He is the creator of PEER GROUP – a show about young people – on Radio 4 and his special LIVE FROM THE BBC is available on Netflix internationally. At the start of the pandemic, he served as the head writer and executive producer of Saturday Night Seder, a star-studded 70-minute special, posted on YouTube, that has so far raised \$3.5 million for the CDC Foundation (COVID-19) Emergency Response Fund. His comedy album "Until Now" was named one of the best comedy albums of 2020 by NPR's Bullseye. He has two differently sized feet.

ADL is proud to partner with Alex and his award-winning comedy special, Just For Us, which heads to Broadway this summer. In the wake of a string of antisemitic threats pointed in his direction online, Edelman decides to go straight to the source; specifically, Queens, where he covertly attends a meeting of White Nationalists and comes face-to-face with the people behind the keyboards. What happens next forms the backbone of the shockingly relevant, utterly hilarious stories that comprise Just For Us. More information about ADL's partnership with the show will be shared soon.

David F. Levine is the Chief Legal Officer of Bloomberg L.P. and serves on the Company's Management Committee. In his capacity as Chief Legal Officer, David oversees the Company's global legal, compliance and risk functions. As a member of the Management Committee, David also has oversight responsibilities for Bloomberg Industry Group, which provides the Bloomberg Law, Bloomberg Government and Bloomberg Tax products.

Since joining the Company, initially as General Counsel in 2012, David has overseen a complete build out of the Company's global legal and compliance functions, matching Bloomberg's impressive business growth by adding broad and deep capabilities across every relevant legal and compliance specialty, while realizing significant cost savings for the Company.

In April 2016, the Legal & Compliance Department launched its award-winning pro bono program, which has shown impressive growth in projects, hours and participation each year. Over the past four years, Department members have contributed nearly 20,000 hours of time, with approximately 95% of the global department participating annually in the voluntary program. David is actively engaged in the program, having advised low-income micro-entrepreneurs on starting small businesses, assisted green card holders with naturalization applications, judged Legal Outreach's Debater of the Year Competition, counseled LGBTQ+ immigrants on eligibility for seeking asylum and volunteered for the non-partisan Election Protection project.

David is an active leader in the legal profession through his involvement in a wide range of Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) and civic activities. He serves on: the Board of Directors of the New York City Bar Association (and is prior Chair of the City Bar Fund, which oversees CityBar's Justice Center, Office of Diversity & Inclusion, Lawyer Assistance Program and Vance Center for International Justice); the Board of Directors of Legal Services NYC; the Board of Counselors of Equal Justice Works; and Union College's President's Council. David is a member of the New York State Business Council on Access to Justice and is a Founding General Counsel and member of the Advisory Board of the "Move the Needle" Fund, an innovative initiative to enhance diversity across the legal profession. He is also co-Executive Sponsor of Bloomberg's Black Professional Community. Under David's leadership, Bloomberg's Legal & Compliance Department is regularly recognized for its outstanding pro bono and DEI programs.

Prior to joining Bloomberg, David was a partner in the Corporate and Financial Services department of Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP, where he counseled clients on a broad range of media and technology-driven transactions. David holds a J.D. from the New York University School of Law, an M.Sc. from the London School of Economics, and a B.A. from Union College. A native New Yorker and a proud product of the New York City public school system, David is a graduate of Stuyvesant High School.

2023 EDWARD BRODSKY FOUNDERS AWARD RECIPIENT

The Edward Brodsky Founders Award was established in memory of Edward Brodsky, a prominent New York lawyer and Senior Partner with Proskauer Rose. Edward was a co-founder of ADL's Lawyers Division, strong champion of ADL's work and believed the law is a vehicle for civil rights, social justice, and peaceful conflict resolution.

As a founding partner of Bernstein Litowitz Berger & Grossmann, Max Berger has grown the firm into what the Financial Times described as "one of the most powerful securities class action law firms in the United States." His prosecution of seminal cases has increased market transparency, held wrongdoers accountable, and improved corporate business practices in groundbreaking ways. Max has litigated many of the firm's most high-profile and significant cases and secured some of the largest recoveries ever achieved in securities fraud lawsuits, negotiating eight of the largest securities fraud settlements in history, each in excess of a billion dollars.

Max's cases have resulted in sweeping corporate governance overhauls and are credited with helping to restore the integrity of capital markets by holding corporate officers, auditors, underwriters, and boards of directors accountable to victims of corporate wrongdoing.

Max's career accolades have garnered him numerous awards and extensive media coverage in major business and legal publications, including the Wall Street Journal, New York Times, Businessweek, New York Law Journal, National Law Journal, The American Lawyer, Chambers USA, Benchmark Litigation, Law 360, and Legal 500.

Recognizing his remarkable track record, he's been referred to as the "Investors' Billion-Dollar Fraud Fighter," the "Dean" of the U.S. plaintiff securities bar, and "Titan of the Plaintiff's Bar." He was also selected as one of the "100 Most Influential Lawyers in America" by the National Law Journal.

Chambers USA presented Max with its USA Award for Excellence for his "Oustanding Contribution to the Legal Profession," describing him as a "standard-bearer" for the legal profession during his nearly 50-year career. In presenting this prestigious honor, Chambers recognized Max's unique stature among colleagues – "warmly lauded by his peers, who are nevertheless loath to find him on the other side of the table." Most recently, Max was presented with a "Lifetime Achievement" award by the New York Law Journal for his impact on the legal community and the practice of law.

In addition to his distinguished career, Max is an advocate for equality, justice, and reform. He has sought to make a difference in communities locally and globally by bringing his business and legal talents to countless organizations including being a proud and ardent supporter of the ADL. He has long worked to help address many of the humanitarian issues we face today including public education, poverty, diversity and inclusion, antisemitism, bigotry, racial and economic injustice, and domestic violence and indigent women's rights.

Max is also dedicated to service in the academic community - he served as the President of the Baruch College Fund from 2015-2019 and now serves as its Chairman. He endowed the Max Berger Pre-Law Program at Baruch College in 2007. Max is also a member of the Dean's Council to Columbia Law School and the Columbia Law School Public Interest/Public Service Council. Max recently endowed the Max Berger '71 Public Interest/Public Service Fellows Program at Columbia Law School. Max and his wife, Dale, previously endowed the Dale and Max Berger Public Interest Law Fellowship at Columbia Law School and, under Max's leadership, BLB&G also created the Bernstein Litowitz Berger & Grossmann Public Interest Law Fellowship at Columbia.

A celebrated photographer, Max has held two successful photography shows that raised hundreds of thousands of dollars for City Year New York and Her Justice.

Prior to forming her own business, Heidi was a senior executive at Viacom for 13 years, where she oversaw multiple global licensing initiatives and new business projects for both MTV and Nickelodeon.






